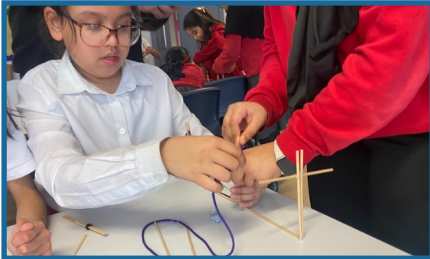
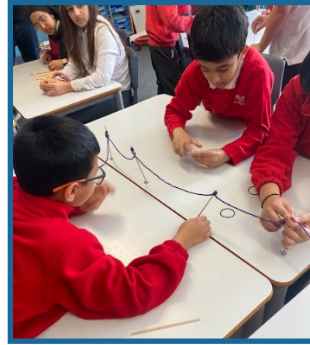
I enjoyed stem day because I got the chance to work with with different people My favourite part was building a house as a class.
